Re: Formal Complaint of Unprofessional Conduct by Dr. Hall
File number: CR 2021 – 017

Further to a Notice of Complaint dated November 10, 2021, I have now completed, under s.55(2)(d) of the *Health Professions Act*, an investigation into this matter. I have determined that you have failed to meet the minimum standards as set out by administering injections without authorization and advising on schedule I drugs.

Additionally, I have found that you have failed to meet the requirements of the CNDA Administrative Policy: Applying for Activities Requiring Authorization, the CNDA Code of Ethics, Scope of Practice, and the following CNDA Standards of Practice:

1. Collaboration in Patient Care;
2. Consent;
3. General;
4. Records Keeping; and,
5. Naturopathic Injection Therapy.

I find that there are reasonable grounds that your conduct constitutes unprofessional conduct as defined by the *Health Professions Act*, RSA 2000, sections 1(1)(pp)(i) and (ii) which are supported by the findings made in the investigation report associated with this matter (as attached). I am prepared to resolve this complaint with you by way of an undertaking which will include the following terms:

1. You will discontinue offering naturopathic injection therapies immediately and you may not offer naturopathic injection therapies until you are duly authorized by the Registrar to do so;
2. A reprimand will be placed on your registration file;
3. You will pay a fine of \$1,000 on or before July 31, 2022;
4. You will pay a portion of the CNDA investigation costs amounting to \$1,000 on or before July 31, 2022;
5. You agree to a suspension of your practice permit and authorization to practice for a period of one (1) month as follows;


- a. June 1, 2022-June 16, 2022; and,
 - b. July 2, 2022 – July 17, 2022.
6. You acknowledge that any future failure to comply with the terms herein will result in immediate suspension of your practice permit and referral to the complaints process;
 7. You acknowledge that the terms of this agreement will be used in any future discipline proceedings with the CNDA; and,
 8. You agree to publication of this matter, including your name and clinic name.

Please provide your response on or before May 16, 2022.

You are entitled to seek legal advice before agreeing to the terms of this undertaking.




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
